- ❖ **Credentials will be checked before each team is permitted to take the ice.**
- ❖ **Games will be played at the Casper Ice Arena in Casper, Wyoming. Located at 1801 East 4<sup>th</sup> Street. Driving Instructions: From I-25N: I-25N to Business I-25 BL/US-20/US-26/US-87/North Beverly St./Bryan Stock which is exit 186. Stay straight to go onto I-25 BL/US-87. I-25 BL/US-87 becomes N. Beverly St./US-87. N. Beverly to E. 4th St. East (right) on 4th St. Arena is on the left.**
- ❖ **Please provide a team picture for the program.**
- ❖ **Hospitality is provided for all players and their families each morning in the skybox overlooking the ice rink until 10:00am.**
- ❖ **Locker room keys are checked out at the front desk in the lobby of the Casper Ice Arena to the coach or manager of each team. Your vehicle keys will be held by the front desk until the locker room key is returned and the locker room is checked for damage. You will be required to check the locker room before and after use. Any team causing damage to a locker room will be required to make arrangements for repair and restitution with the City of Casper before leaving the rink.**

## TOURNAMENT RULES and REGULATIONS

It is the intent of CAHC to provide a fun and competitive tournament for all of the participants and all of the spectators. Good Sportsmanship is expected of all participants. Improper and abusive behavior will not be tolerated! It is the responsibility of each coach to control his team and exemplify good sportsmanship.

- The 2009 Casper Amateur Hockey Club Tournament will be a sanctioned USA Hockey tournament and governed by its rules and regulations.
- Team credentials will be checked prior to playing the first game. Any player not meeting USA Hockey guidelines will not be allowed to take the ice. This is an issue of liability and insurance and will be strictly enforced.
- All referee rulings will be upheld; any protests must be submitted in writing, within one-hour following the game in question to the Tournament Director.
- **"ZERO TOLERANCE"** will be enforced; players, coaches and spectators are expected to comply. Throwing objects on the ice and/or abusive conduct or language will result in immediate ejection from the arena and the tournament. Failure to comply will result in offending team forfeiting the game. Should any player, coach, parent, or fans willfully damage any property in or outside the arena, all costs for repairs or replacement will be the sole responsibility of the team/individual concerned. Any such infraction may subject the team to disqualification.

### Length of Games:

- All games shall consist of two (2), fifteen (15) minute running clock periods and one (1), twelve (12) minute stop clock period. If the tournament officials determine that the schedule is in jeopardy, they may shorten the warm-up times and the two-minute breaks between periods. In the third period, the clock will run if the goal difference is five (5) or more.
- One (1) time-out will be allowed for each team in any game during the tournament. Each time-out shall be one (1) minute in duration.

### Tournament Play:

- Each team will play three games. Two (2) points will be given for each win, one (1) point will be given for each shutout with a win, one (1) point will be given for a tie, and zero (0) points for each loss.
